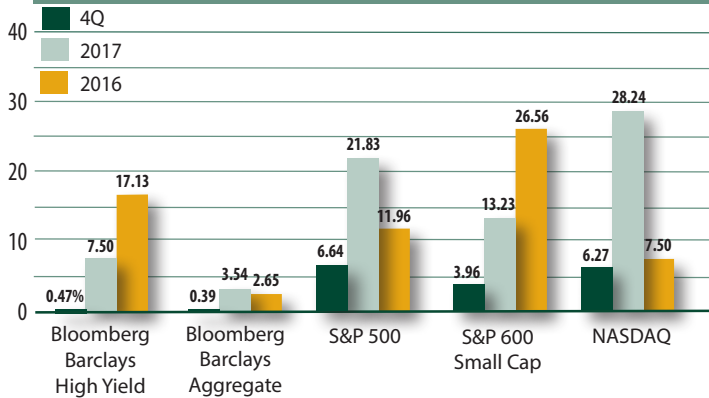

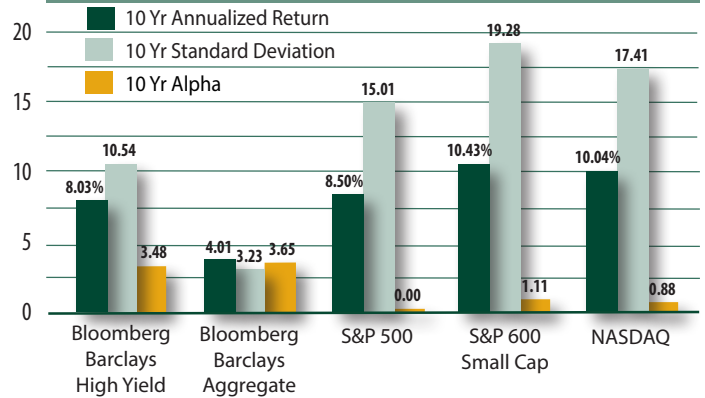

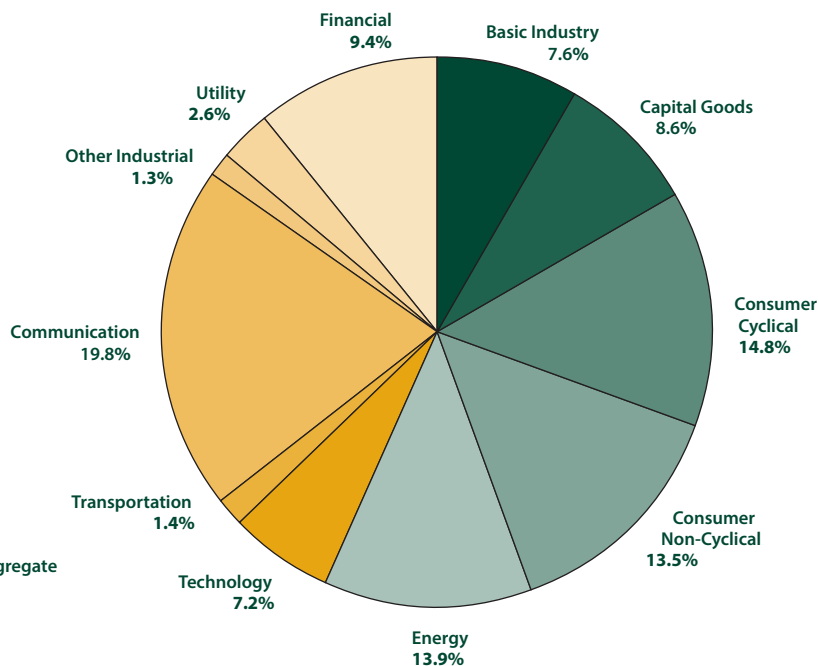
US DEBT MARKET (\$MM)
